Introduction

This is a theoretical-practical course in which the most modern reconstructive techniques will be demonstrated with special interest in flaps harvested from the foot and both digital, hand and forearm replantation techniques. Each participant will be provided with an upper limb specimen (forearm and hand) and a lower limb specimen (foot). The tutor-to-participant ratio will be 1:2. The surgical techniques will be demonstrated by tutors at the main table and then performed by the participants. The goal of the course is to offer advanced training in complex hand reconstructions and replantation, supported by world-renowned tutors.
